**STAFF REPORT**

**Item 4. Project Status Update**

- A. The Army Corps of Engineers will provide a short memo on the status of the Unit 4 project NEPA/CEQA environmental impact process and the changes to their overall timeline due to a change in federal allocation to the project.
- B. Phil Stevens, Executive Director of the Urban Creeks Council (UCC) will provide an update on the Streamside Management Program for Landowners (SMPL). UCC staff have met with over 50 property owners in the Ross Valley. Phil will summarize what they've seen and what progress is being made.
- C. Ross Valley Feasibility Study – James Reilly, Supervising Engineer for Stetson Engineers will present a summary of *Technical Memo #1- Existing Conditions Analysis* and answer questions on the feasibility study. {The memo is available for downloading at <http://www.rossvalleywatershed.org> }.

- All required maintenance on the flood control channel has been carried out. Overhanging vegetation has been trimmed, all flap gates have been serviced, and the fish resting pools have been cleared of gravel and debris

- Our maintenance team clears the fish ladder in Ross of debris before and after all significant rain storms
